DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 - BUCHAREST, ROMANIA

Welcome to Bucharest—the "Paris of the East" The day is yours to relax and enjoy Bucharest.

Day 2 - BUCHAREST-BRASOV

Join a guided excursion in Bucharest, see the royal palace square—the scene of the city's 1989 riots to overthrow the communist dictator Nicolae Ceausescu. This afternoon continue to Brasov for the night.

Day 3 - BRASOV
